

TARTU CHESS FESTIVAL | REGULATIONS

1. PURPOSE

- b) Determining the best players of Tartu Chess Festival
- c) Commemoration of Toomas Virro
- d) Introducing Tartu as the European capital of culture

2. TIME AND PLACE

The festival will take place on 26-28 April in the Tartu <u>Comb Factory</u> event centre's production building (Teguri 28a, 50107, Tartu). The following events will be organised as part of the Tartu Chess Festival:

- 26.04: Alexela international U12 children's tournament
- 26.04: Estiko international blitz tournament
- 27.-28.04: Tartu Open | Toomas Virro memorial in rapid chess

4. **REGISTRATION**

5. TOURNAMENT SYSTEM AND TIE-BREAK REGULATIONS

The festival will be organised according to the FIDE Laws of Chess. All tournaments will be held in the Swiss system and will go into the calculation of both Estonian and FIDE ratings.

Alexela U12 children's tournament:

- 6-7 rounds (depending on the number of participants)
- The tournament will be played as a single event, but the rankings will be determined separately in the U8 (born in 2016 or later), U10 (born in 2014 or later), and U12 (born in 2012 or later) age groups, for both open and girls' categories.
- Time control: 10 minutes per player + 3 extra seconds for each move

Estiko Blitz:

- 11 rounds
- Time control: 3 minutes per player + 2 extra seconds for each move

Tartu Open | Toomas Virro memorial in rapid chess:

- 11 rounds
- Time control: 12 minutes per player + 3 extra seconds for each move

In case of equal points between two or more chess players, the tie-break will be as follows:

- a) results of direct encounters between the tied players
- b) reduced Buchholz-1 (sum of opponents' points excluding the weakest result)
- c) reduced Buchholz-2 (sum of opponents' points excluding the 2 weakest results)
- d) Buchholz (sum of opponents' points)
- e) highest number of games played with black

All disputes will be resolved by the chief arbiter of the tournament.





6. PRIZES

• Alexela children's tournament

In each age group (U8, U10, U12), the ranking will be determined separately for both open and girls' categories: the top three will receive a souvenir, and the winner will receive a trophy. All players will receive a commemorative diploma, and many lottery prizes will also be distributed!
